ELIGIBILITY

- Must be of Samoan or part-Samoan heritage
- Senior attending any high school in the State of Washington
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Letter of Acceptance to a 2- or 4-year college, university, or trade school

REQUIREMENT

- Complete the entire application and the attached (3) three Essay Questions.
- Provide a certified high school transcript, to be mailed by the high school to: Samoan Scholarships Committee c/o Mrs. Lua Pritchard, Asia Pacific Cultural Center, 4851 South Tacoma Way, Tacoma, WA, 98409
- Two letters of Recommendations from any school official (teacher, counselor, or coach), church official, or community member who knows you well
- Application package is due June 1, 2018.

PROCESS & DEADLINE

- June 1, 2018: Application packet due date
- June 6, 2018: Applications Review by Scholarship Committee
- June 13, 2018: Final Selection of Scholarship Recipients
- June 14, 2018: Notification to Recipients via mail and email
- Saturday, July 14, 2018: Cultural Celebration Day and Scholarship Awards

Successful applicants will be announced and presented their awards during the Event Programs, and must attend to be awarded and acknowledged. If you are unable to attend with a valid reason, you may designate your parent(s) to accept your award on your behalf. You will be notified of the event with instructions by mail and a phone call follow-up from the Scholarship Committee.

Note that in addition to your scholarship awards, you and your (2) parents will be special guests at the Samoan Cultural Celebration Dinner Banquet on July 8, 2016. The location and time of this event will be announced in your Scholarship Awards Letter and notification.
